

## MISSION AND OUTREACH GRANT FUNDING GUIDELINES

Grant applications from organizations are requested in October of each year. They are reviewed in November by the M+O Ministry Team for recommendation at our annual all-church meeting in January. There should be a liaison to the organization who is a church member. If funded, the organization will be notified in the spring and provided details of the grant.

## Mission and Outreach Ministry Team Guidelines

- 1. UCC Norwell strives to establish a balance between local, national and international organizations
- 2. Preference will be given to organizations that provide "hands-on" mission activities
- 3. It is important that each organization has a direct liaison with UCC Norwell
- 4. UCC Norwell funding applications are for one year; applications for new and existing activities/programs will need to be submitted annually
- 5. Agencies that are funded are asked to provide a progress report of how the funding was used

## Mission and Outreach Project Selection Guidelines

The types of projects and activities that UCC Norwell funds include, but are not limited to:

- 1. 501(c)(3) organizations that support our core values and mission and do not discriminate against race, religion, creed, gender, sexual orientation and national origin
- 2. UCC denominational endeavors (e.g., OCWM, start-up churches, emergency support)
- 3. Organizations that provide advocacy for social justice issues (e.g., hunger, homelessness, racial injustice, domestic violence, poverty) and the environment
- 4. Individual scholarships for recognized UCC Norwell activities
- 5. Seed money for projects that fall within M & O funding guidelines

## UCC Norwell will not fund:

- Fundraising activities/capital campaigns
- Research
- Governmental agencies
- Individuals
